The youngest of seven children, Val Demings was raised to believe she could achieve anything if she put her mind to it. After graduating from Jacksonville's public schools, Demings received a B.S. in Criminology from Florida State University and a Masters degree in Public Administration from Webster University. Demings spent her early career as a Social Worker focused on foster care, and then joined the police force in Orlando. She retired as the Chief of Police after 27 years service.

"I will never let Washington politicians legislate personal decisions that belong to women and their doctors. I will work in Washington to expand paid Family and Medical leave and work toward pay equity so women earn equal pay for equal work."

Val Demings has been endorsed by both the National NOW PAC and the Florida State NOW PAC.

It is critical that we elect Feminist champions to Congress!

There are 11 new Amendments to the Florida Constitution on the ballot.

VOTE NO!

Amendments #6 and # 8 are of great concern.

Right of Privacy

"Amendment 6 allows politicians in Tallahassee to intrude between a woman, her doctor and her faith.

Separation of Church and State

Amendment 8 allows religious groups and institutions, who do not pay taxes to receive tax dollars with no oversight or accountability" Donna Slutiak.
